**GENERAL INFORMATION:** All students and faculty are invited to participate in AMCOP 68 by presenting a 10-minute oral presentation or a demonstration/poster describing recent parasitological research. The

**AWARDS:** AMCOP has always placed an emphasis on student participation. Students may compete for awards individually or they may coauthor with another student. The Herrick Award and \$300 is given for the best demonstration/poster, the LaRue Award and \$300 is given for best oral presentation. The Cable award and \$200 is presented to the best undergraduate presentation. Honorable Mention awards of \$100 may also be awarded.

### **PLEASE FOLLOW THE FOLLOWING FOR YOUR ABSTRACT:**

1. Name of Author(s) in CAPS. Put the name of the primary presenter in bold and caps. Indicate if authors are an undergraduate (UG) or graduate student (GS), major professor (MP), post-doc (PD), technician (T), etc. after the name.
2. Professional Address
3. Give the type of presentation:
  - a) Oral paper (using PowerPoint)
  - b) Demonstration/poster
  - c) Symposium talk
  - d) Banquet address
4. Is this a student presentation? If you are a student, you are automatically in competition for the Herrick, LaRue, or Cable awards unless you specify otherwise.
5. Will you require any special equipment (microscopes, computer for a demonstration, etc.)?
6. Prepare your abstract in the style as shown in the following example.
