1. Length: 5 pages
2. Writing Style: a) Active voice b) Parallelism, past tense
3. Grammar usage: Correct and efficient
4. Style manual followed: APA, MLA, or other preferred (just be consistent)
5. Content: Examples, details, independent research; Introduction, body, conclusion
